Changes to Time or Location

Any changes to the event time, venue, or performance location after this Agreement has been signed must be approved by the Contractor.

Additional fees may apply if changes result in:

- Additional travel time or distance.
- Additional waiting time.
- A longer performance period.
- Additional setup requirements.
- A venue change requiring extra labor or equipment.

The Contractor will notify the Client of any additional charges before the performance.

Client Responsibilities

The Client agrees to:

- Provide safe access to the performance area.
- Inform the Contractor in advance of any stairs, elevators, parking restrictions, loading requirements, or COI requirements.
- Provide a safe performance environment.

Independent Contractor Status

The Contractor is an independent contractor and is not an employee of the Client. The Contractor is responsible for all applicable taxes, insurance, and business expenses.

Force Majeure

Neither party shall be liable for failure to perform due to circumstances beyond their reasonable control, including but not limited to severe weather, natural disasters, government restrictions, or other emergencies.

Entire Agreement

This Agreement represents the complete understanding between the parties and may only be modified in writing and signed by both parties.
